

NORTH SOMERSET DISTRICT COUNCIL
RED HILL (A38), REDHILL, NORTH SOMERSET (TEMPORARY 30MPH SPEED
LIMIT) ORDER 2017

Notice is hereby given that the District Council of North Somerset in pursuance of the provisions of section 84 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended, have made an order the effect of which will be to suspend temporarily the existing speed restrictions in favour of restricting temporarily any vehicle to not exceeding 30mph in the lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this notice.

This order was required to control traffic flow due to the likelihood of danger to the public and to protect the workforce consequent upon works by Bristol Water to install a new water main. This will become operative on the **17th July 2017** for a maximum period of eighteen months. However, the speed restriction may not be implemented for the whole of the period but only as necessitated by the works which is anticipated to be **four weeks** in duration. Speed restriction signs displayed give effect to the order.

REDHILL (A38) – the 30mph restriction commences at property Quarry Farm (Business Units) and continues in a north easterly direction for approximately two hundred and eighty five metres to property Mendip View.
