We have been asked by Congresbury Parish Council to ask all Patients attending the Surgery at Congresbury not to park in the Old School Rooms Car Park.

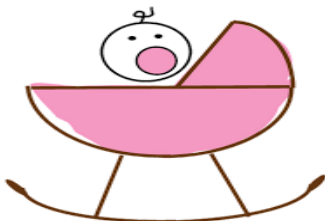
Alternative parking is available next to The Ship & Castle Pub by the traffic lights. We apologise for any inconvenience caused by this decision.
