Final Notice of Temporary Traffic Regulation Order  
Nates Lane, Langford Road, Ladymead Lane, Wrington, Langford North Somerset  
Temporary Prohibition of Use by Vehicles Order 2024  
Date coming Into Force: 29th July 2024

Ref: SW24.25-87

Notice is hereby given that North Somerset Council in pursuance of the provisions of section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, have made an order the effect of which will be to close, temporarily, to vehicles the lengths of roads specified in the Schedule to this Notice. Exemptions are included for emergency services, works access, works vehicles and as works permit for premises which may only be accessed via the closed section of roads.

This order was required because of the likelihood of danger to the public consequent upon work by Openreach for visual structural and safety checks of manholes,. This will become operative on the 29th July 2024 for a maximum period of eighteen months. However, the phased closures may not be implemented for the whole of the period but only as necessitated by the works which is now anticipated to **commence 16th September 2024** & be of **1 night in duration between 20.00hrs & 06.00hrs for approximately 30 minutes at each location.** Appropriate traffic signs will be displayed when the measures are in force for each phase of the works..

Schedule - **Nates Lane**-outside Wrington Green Organic Farm to A38, **Langford Lane**- near property Arymer and **Ladymead Lane** between Blackmore Lane & Saxon Street
